



Summer School 2021

We offered summer school provision to 141 of our current and future pupils. We invited all of our Pupil Premium children across all year groups if they needed recovery learning. Pupils came and spent some time with us during the last two weeks of the summer holidays; some pupils were not able to attend for the entire fortnight. We were able to staff the sessions with our teaching and support staff making full use of some of our facilities, including a purpose - built outdoor classroom.

The mornings were spent covering math and English core skills that had been set by our subject leaders prior to the Summer School. After a wholesome hot lunch our pupils were able to choose which activities they took part in, this enabled friendships to flourish after what has been a challenging period for some of our students. Afternoon activities included sporting activities, bush-craft, tie dye t-shirts, First Aid, story-telling, drama workshops as well as craft activities.

For our new children joining us in year 5 we had our transition mentor join us for some of both weeks so that tours of our site could take place along with seeing a familiar face who had been supporting the pupils through their transition to join us.
