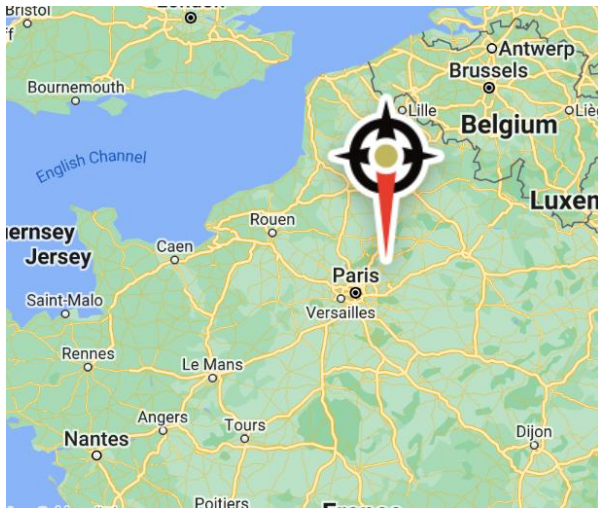

Rooming arrangements

LUGGAGE

KIT LIST

- **Essentials**

- Passport/ VISA (if necessary)
- GHIC card
- Medication (labelled with instructions)
- Money £20 and 90 euros. 15 euros for lunch in Paris, 20 euros for lunch at Disney and 20 euros for lunch and dinner in Calais. Please separate in named envelopes. Remaining money (35 euros) for souvenirs/ extras. Additional money is at your discretion. Coins for toilets.

- **Day bag for coach**

- Secure purse/wallet with money for the journey (£ and euros)
- Sun cream, sun hat/cap
- Camera
- Packed breakfast and lunch, plenty of snacks, water bottle (named)
- Cards, games, book for the journey. A pillow is useful for the long coach journey.

- **Large bag/suitcase** (not accessible until at the hotel)

- Waterproof jacket, comfortable shoes/trainers, hairdryer + adaptor, toiletries, sanitary products, general day wear, **no football shirts or very revealing tops and shorts especially on the first day**. Watch/alarm clock.

All bags and belongings labelled if possible.

VALUABLES

- Children take responsibility for all items
- Mobile phones or any electronic equipment that is internet compatible is not allowed
- No items of sentimental or high monetary value

FOOD

- All breakfasts and evening meals are included in the trip cost, apart from:
 - on Monday a **packed breakfast and lunch (and snacks)** will be needed
- Pupils will **purchase 3 lunches**, to ensure they eat and we avoid the vast wastage of the mediocre and expensive hotel packed lunches
- Also **dinner at the hypermarket** on the last day

HEALTH/ DIET UPDATE

- Check your child's medical and dietary requirements are correct on Arbor. You can find these on the main menu under 'profile', dietary requirements / medical conditions. Please let the office know of any changes.
- Medical supplies need to be clearly labelled with name and clear administration instructions and handed to the group leader on departure.
- The consent forms will be given to students to take home on 1st June 2026 and be returned that week.
- If your child deals with their own medication normally, please inform us.

Passport/GHIC/Insurance

- All pupils **must** have their passport and GHIC card with them. VISA if necessary.
- A reminder that we need uploaded copies to the link on the original letter sent out in March.
- Group leaders will look after them during the trip and hand them back on our return.
- Insurance is included - £30 excess on claims.

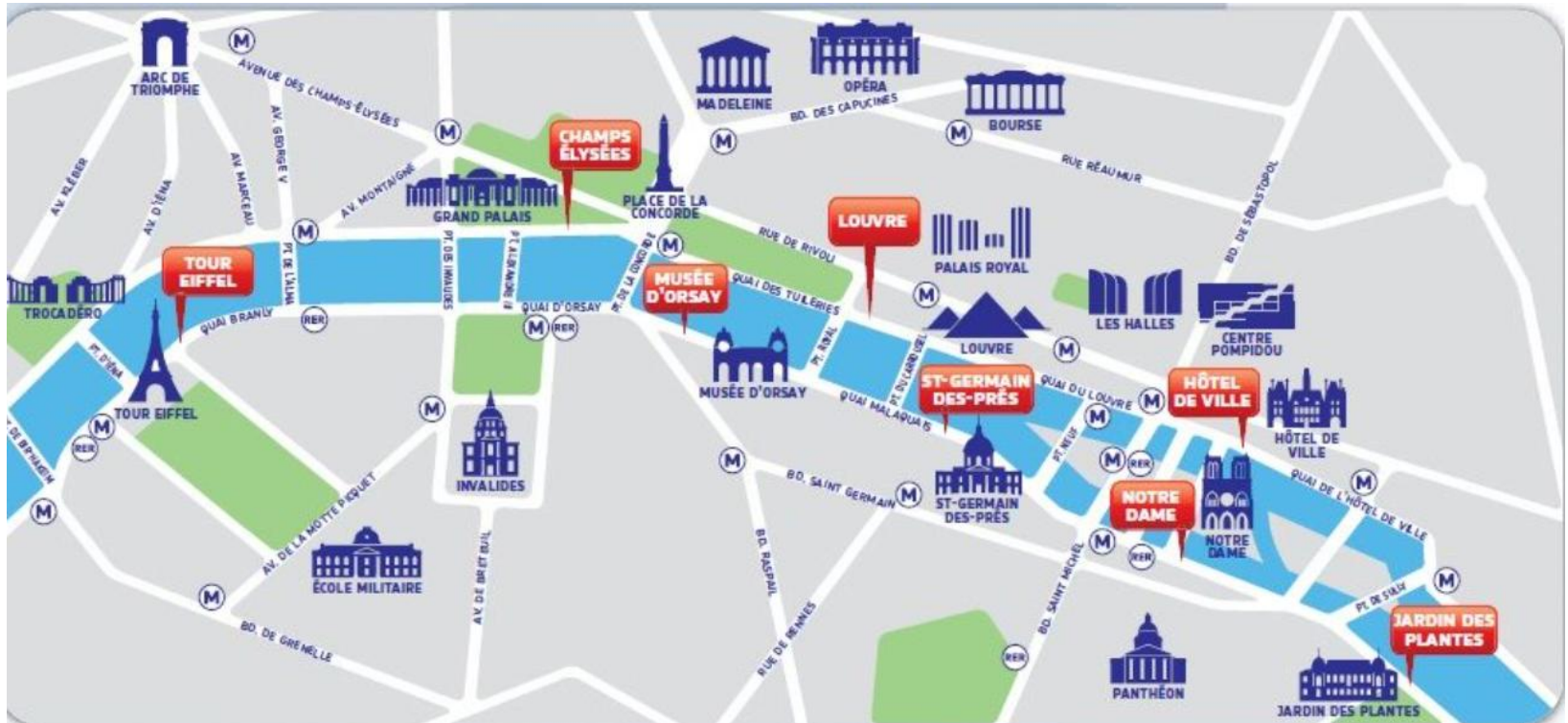

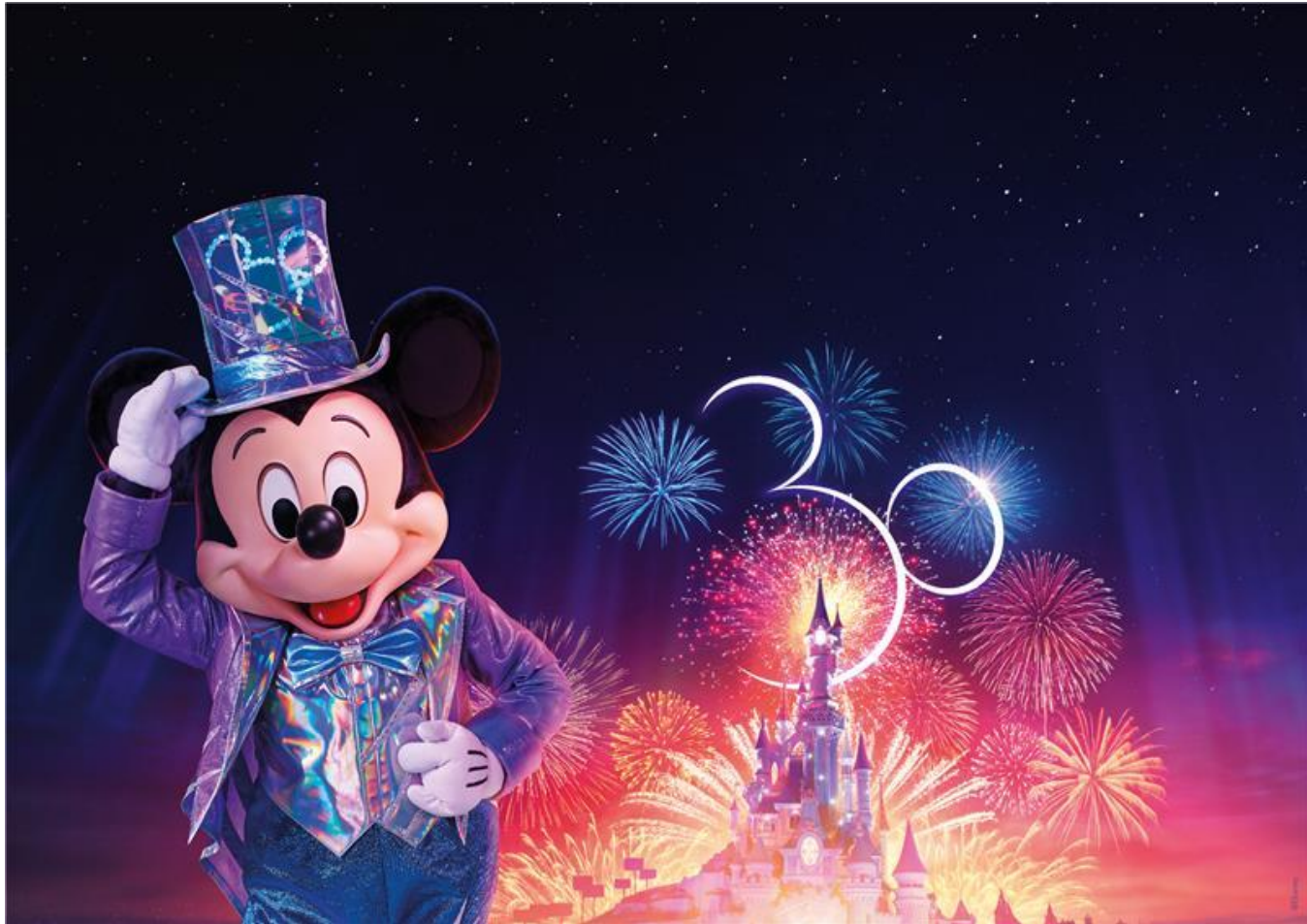
