Timeline

1509—Henry VIII becomes king and marries Catherine of Aragon.



annulled

1533—Henry VIII marries Anne Boleyn and created the Church of England, also becoming Supreme Head.



executed

1536—Anne Boleyn is executed. Henry VIII marries Jayne Seymour.



died

1540, Jan—Henry VIII marries Anne of Cleves.



divorced

1540, Jul—Henry VIII marries Catherine Howard.



executed

1543—Henry marries Catherine Parr.



survived

1547—Henry VIII dies.

Key Vocabulary

	Church of England	the leading Christian church in England with the king or queen as its head
	Catholic	the oldest form of Christianity with the Pope in charge
	Protestant	members of the Church of England (not Catholic)
	Supreme Head	a title given to the king/queen - making them head of the Church of England
	Mass	a special religious service where Christians celebrate the Eucharist
	Eucharist	aka Holy Communion where Christians remember Jesus Christ and the last supper
	Archbishop	The highest-ranking bishop - priest or minister
	monastery / monasteries	special places where monks live together
	reformation	to reform or change, often for the better
	divorce/ annulment	the ending of a marriage as recognised by law / making a marriage invalid - similar but different to divorce
	heir	the next in line to another person's property or throne
	monarch	someone who rules a country: a king or queen
	chronology / chronologically	the order in which things happen, from earliest to most recent
	persecution	causing someone or a group of people to suffer or treating them unfairly
