Good and bad touch – touch can be **good** or **bad** – people touch you for different reasons. Some touch feels bad, but is necessary.

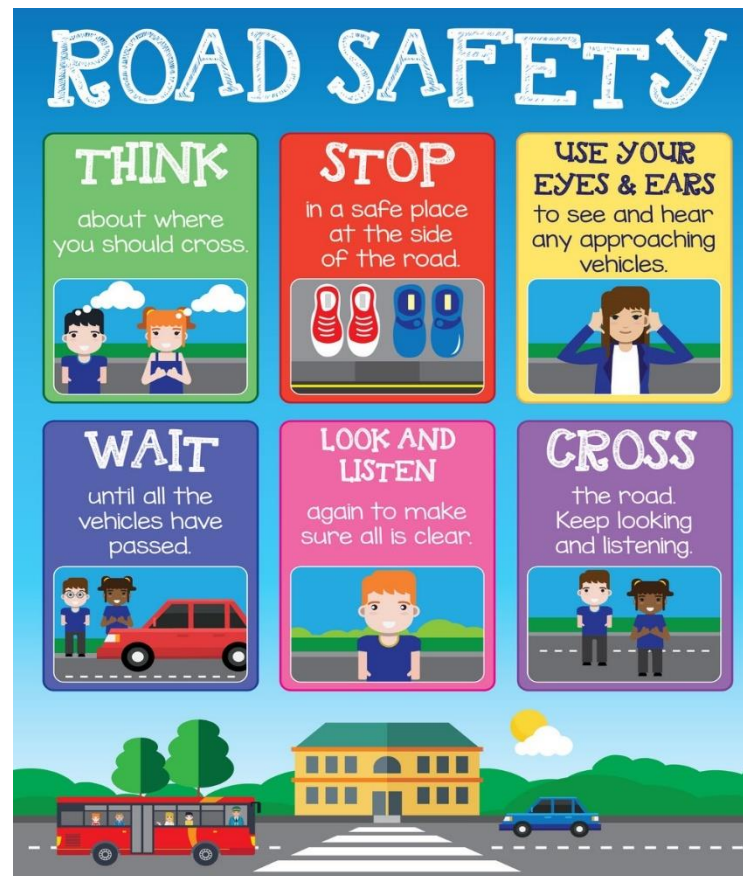
You should never be asked to keep secrets about touch.
