



Enrichment Week Code of Conduct & Behaviour Contract 2026

We expect all students to uphold the school rules and expectations throughout the week and to always be **READY, RESPECTFUL & SAFE**. We will not accept:

- Anti-social or disruptive behaviour – any actions that negatively affect the safety or enjoyment of themselves or others including poor attitude, repeated breaches of the school rules/expectations, any form of bullying, aggressive behaviour or intimidation, sexual assault (which is any unwanted sexual behaviour that causes humiliation, pain, fear or intimidation) vandalism, theft, fighting, smoking/vaping, racist, sexist, homophobic or discriminatory behaviour.
- The use of loud or offensive language, swearing or profane language.
- Damaging or destroying of property/equipment.
- Possession of any prohibited item. These are: **mobile phones, tablets, smart watches or any electronic equipment that has access to the internet**, knives or weapons, alcohol, illegal drugs, stolen items, smoking materials including tobacco, cigarette papers, cigarettes, vapes, lighters or fireworks.
- Girls in boy's rooms/tents or vice versa (residential)

CONSEQUENCES

In the unlikely event of persistent/repeated poor behaviour that risks the safety or enjoyment of others, we will be forced to ask that the parents/carers collect their child. St Osmund's will not reimburse any travelling expenses incurred in doing this, nor will you be able to claim any reimbursement for the shortened duration of their trip.

- treat all adults with respect and show good manners
- follow any instruction given by a member of staff (including centre staff on residential)
